

ESOL Teacher of the Year Award

Nomination Award, LIESOL 2018

This award was established by Molloy College's LIESOL Committee in 2002 to recognize the efforts of outstanding ESOL and Bilingual teachers in the classroom setting. Award winners will be honored at the March 24, 2018 LIESOL Conference during the opening ceremony.

Selection Criteria

The committee will consider the following:

- Full-time teacher in an ESOL or Bilingual program.
- Evidence of teaching excellence with Innovative and effective practices to support ELLs/MLLs in the classroom adhering to specific expectations set forth by both the district and New York State.
- Willingness to devote time to service the ESOL community by attending professional development opportunities, participating in parent and community outreach, understanding and staying up-to-date with current research in the field.
- Contributing to the education of ELLs/MLLs in the school, district, or community through mentoring roles and leadership opportunities.
- Establishing and maintaining an environment of acceptance, equality, and respect for students, colleagues, administrators, and parents.

How to Nominate

- A direct administrator must submit a nomination for a potential award recipient.
- The nomination consists of (a) a one- to two-page letter written by their administrator that provides specific examples of the nominee's merit based on the above criteria and (b) a complete curriculum vitae of the nominee.
